You and all other students statewide in public, private, home, and charter schools, will lead the way in the 2010 Primary and General Elections. You are showing how on-line voting can work. You and your peers are the future of our country...the leaders of tomorrow... the keepers of democracy. Your choices today will get you into the habit of voting in every election for the rest of your adult lives. Go to kidsvotinghawaii.org to cast your votes in the **Mock Primary Election September 3rd – 18th**. You will not need your personal Student Voter Password until you log on to vote in the 2010 **Kids Voting Hawaii General Election October 19th – November 2nd**. Nearly 120,000 of you logged on to vote in 2008. You can break that record, and then be the first to get your voting results at 6PM Primary and General Election nights...leading the way for voters throughout Hawaii!

Ask your children to take you to kidsvotinghawaii.org for an advance look at virtually the same ballot you will be given, when you go to the polls September 18 and November 2. This year we are offering a Mock Primary Election that is not password-protected, and your children are invited to cast Primary Election ballots, and explore the website. Discuss the elections with your family...help us make this a lesson in democracy! Please set an example and vote in the Primary and General Elections. If your children have not received their passwords, please encourage the school to provide them, because it is one-student one-vote in the password-protected General Election. Kids Voting Hawaii provides an age-appropriate curriculum and classroom activities to help prepare students for this unique, on-line experience in democracy. The curriculum meets Social Studies Standards, and student participation will help measure each school's success in civic responsibility.

Kids Voting Hawaii is a private, nonpartisan, nonprofit organization, dedicated to educating Hawaii's youth about the voting process and good citizenship. Every K-12 student in a public, private, charter, or home school, is eligible to cast a ballot in the 2010 Kids Voting Hawaii Primary and General Elections.
