All of the classrooms have digital cameras and many have Smart Boards and Elmos. Many computers are also available on campus for both the staff and the students use. The bulk of the funds have been used to support staff development and training.

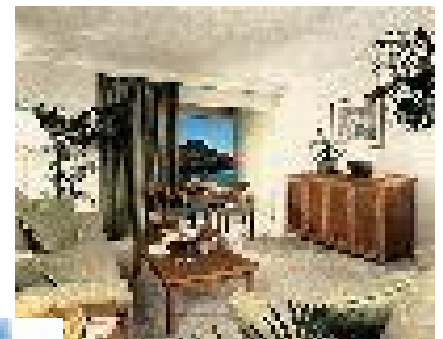
