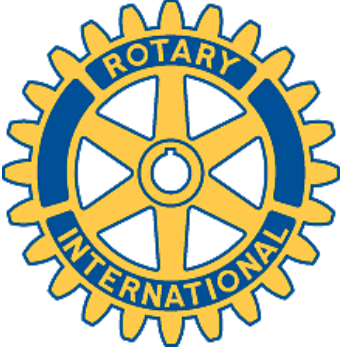

American Red Cross

Coralie Chun Matayoshi has served as the CEO of the American Red Cross, Hawaii State Chapter since 2003. She is an attorney who previously served as Executive Director of the Hawaii State Bar Association for 13 years. She is a

graduate of Punahou School and earned a political science degree, *magna cum laude*, from the University of California, Berkeley. She received her juris doctor degree from Hastings College of the Law in 1981.

Matayoshi has served as a trial attorney for the United States Department of Justice Antitrust Division and Special Assistant United States Attorney in Washington D.C., worked for several years in private practice, served as Chief Policy Analyst for the State Senate Committee on Business Development & Pacific Relations, and as Executive Director of the Hawaii Institute for Continuing Legal Education.

She has also served on numerous community boards and committees, including FOX TV-2 Action Line Advisory Board, American Bar Association Committee on Justice Initiatives, Hawaii Commission on Access to Justice, and Neighborhood Justice Center Board, and Hastings Alumni Association Board of Governors. She served for many years as an editor of the *Hawaii Bar Journal* and is the author of a chapter on "Women & Jobs" in a book entitled *Price of Paradise*. A former 1976 Narcissus Queen, Matayoshi is now a busy career woman and mother of three.

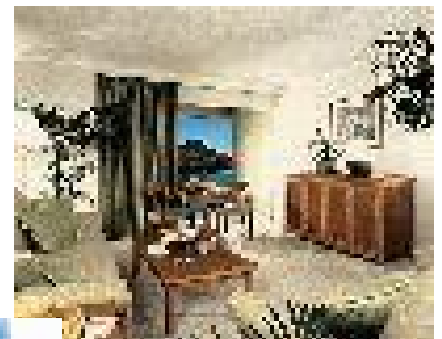
